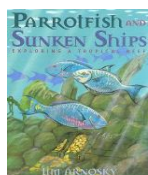

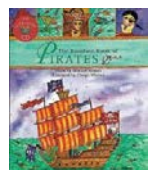

By Jim Arnosky

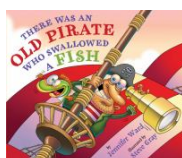

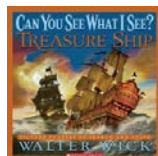
There Was An Old Pirate Who Swallowed A Fish

This variation on the traditional, cumulative song reveals the consequences of a pirate's strange diet.

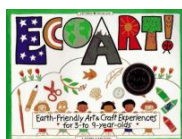


Pirate Treasure Hunt!

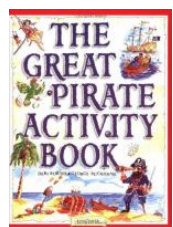


Can You See What I See? Treasure Ship
