




Crystals

INGREDIENTS

½ cup water

2 tbsp. alum powder

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Pour water into the jar. With help from an adult, place the jar in the microwave for 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ minutes.
- 2. Add alum powder into the jar and stir.
- 3. Place paper towel over the jar.
- 4. Let the jar sit for 3 days and do not touch.
- 5. After this, pour the water out of the jar and remove your crystal.
- 6. Set the crystal on paper towel to dry.



Fingerprint tip sheet

What do investigators look for?

Each person has a loop, an arch, or a whorl pattern on their fingers. Most people have loops, but some have whorls, and only a few people have arches.
